

Herne Bay Cemetery

Access - all vehicles subject to one-way system, except those belonging to staff and contractors.

No cycling. No dogs, except guide dogs to assist the blind. No children under 12 years old, unless accompanied by an adult. Road gates open by 8.30am daily and locked at 7.30pm (summer) and 4.30pm (winter), unless otherwise notified. Pedestrian access always available.

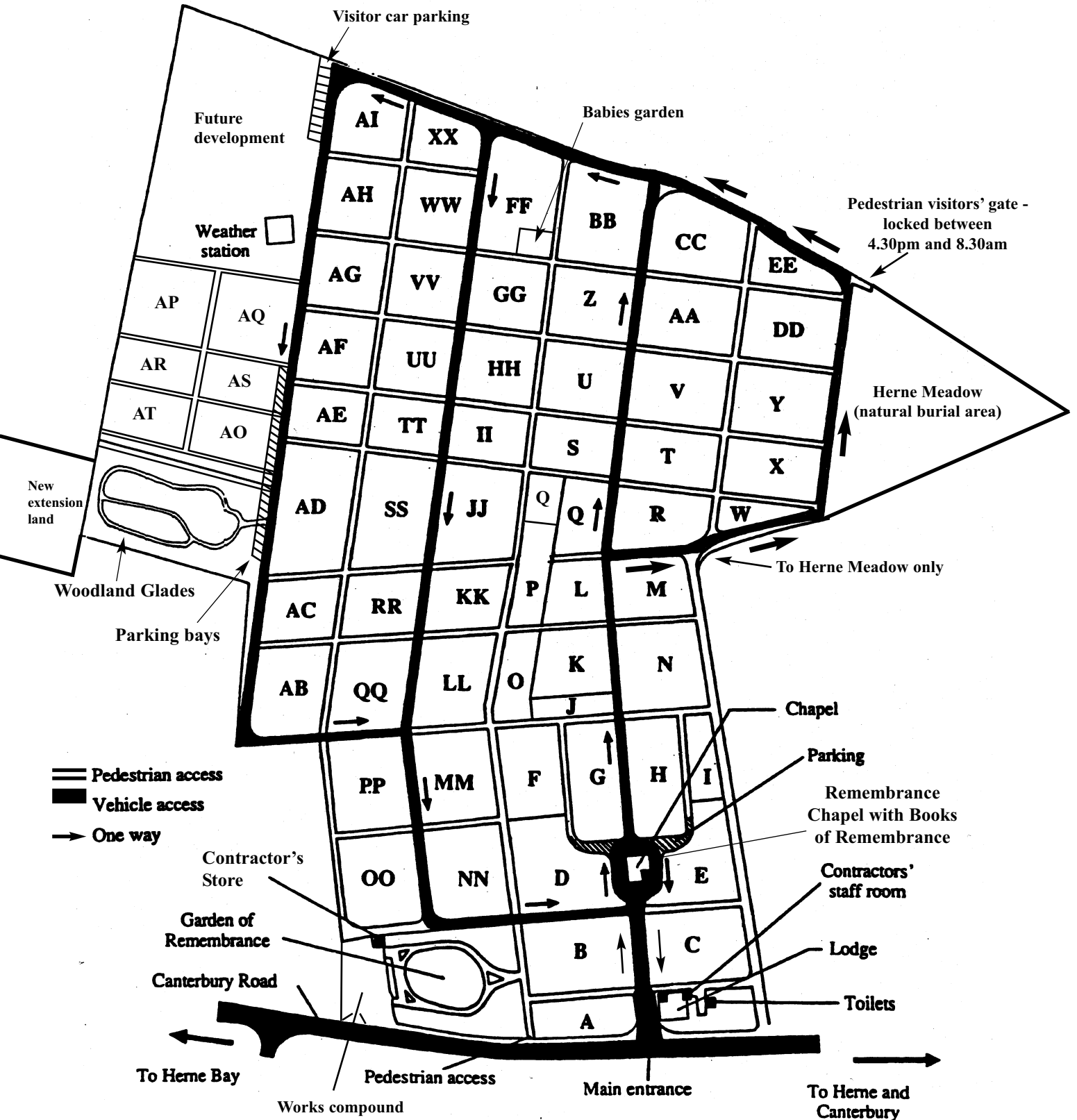

A one way traffic flow system operates in this cemetery - please follow the arrow indicators.



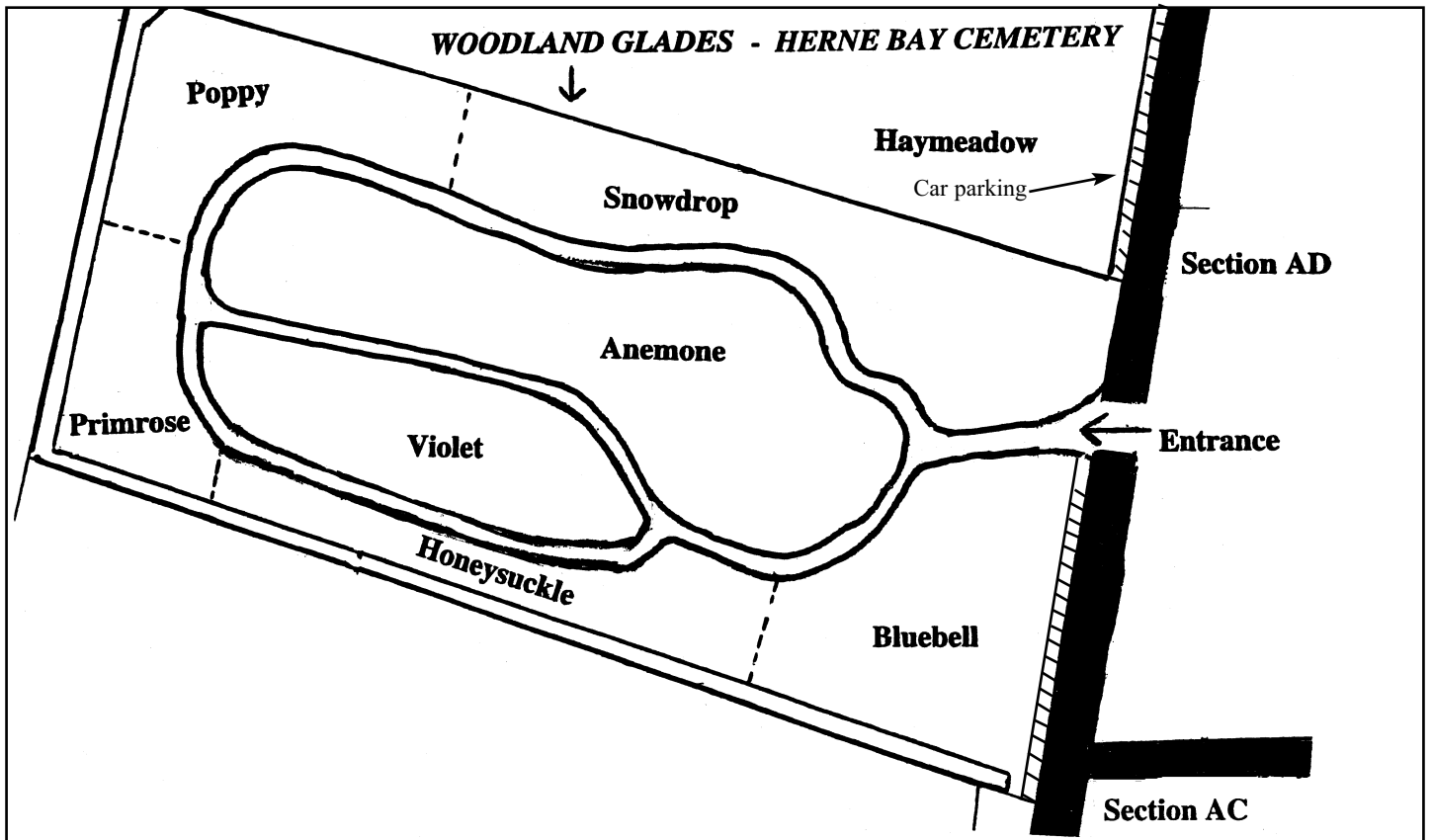
Woodland Glades

A natural habitat for small mammals, birds, insects, plants and flowers which is dedicated to the memory and peaceful repose of those whom we love but see no more.

The area has been set aside for the scattering of cremated remains within the Glades.

It is illegal and an offence to scatter cremated remains within the cemeteries without permission. Each scattering must be registered and properly documented.
